

CHANGE IN TISSUE POLICY

Each child will be responsible to keep and maintain their own supply of tissues. Students are advised to keep tissues in their locker and a small pack in their book bags or desks.

Grade 1

1. 2 boxes of primary colored markers-washable (8 color)
2. 2 pair scissors – **if left handed, please purchase left handed scissors**
3. 16 jumbo glue sticks or 30 regular sized glue sticks OR \$15 check (see below)
4. 3 Two pocket folders-1 blue, 1 green, 1 yellow.
5. 2 Two pocket folders -1 red and 1 orange each with 3 prongs inside
6. 2 black or blue dry erase markers (**NOT** labeled with name)
7. 1 white baby sock
8. 40 pencils (**20 should be sharpened**)
9. Siddur (from kindergarten)
10. Book bag
11. Box of crayons (24-48) NOT 64
12. One 1 ½” D ring binder
13. 1 box gallon size Ziploc bags – boys only (**with name**)
14. 1 box quart size Ziploc bags – girls only (**with name**)
15. 1 package of pencil top erasers (doesn't need labeled)
16. 1 large rectangular eraser
17. 2 boxes of tissues (box labeled)
18. 1 box band aids
19. 1 standard sized school box
20. 6 different color highlighters
21. 2 spiral sketchbooks 8 1/2 x 11 or larger, black paper inside
22. Small manual plastic pencil sharpener that catches pencil shavings
23. Wallet size recent color pictures and 1 baby picture (can be color copied, place in labeled envelope)

Please label each and every item with your child's name or initials, unless specifically stated not to label.

Please organize 1 set of markers, several pencils, 1 glue stick, 1 pair scissors, and large eraser into the school box. Leave all other supplies separate.

If you want the school to buy the glue, please leave a \$15 check in Mrs. Duff's mailbox by August 13, made out to CHDS with 1st grade supplies on memo of check.

Grade 2 & Grade 3
